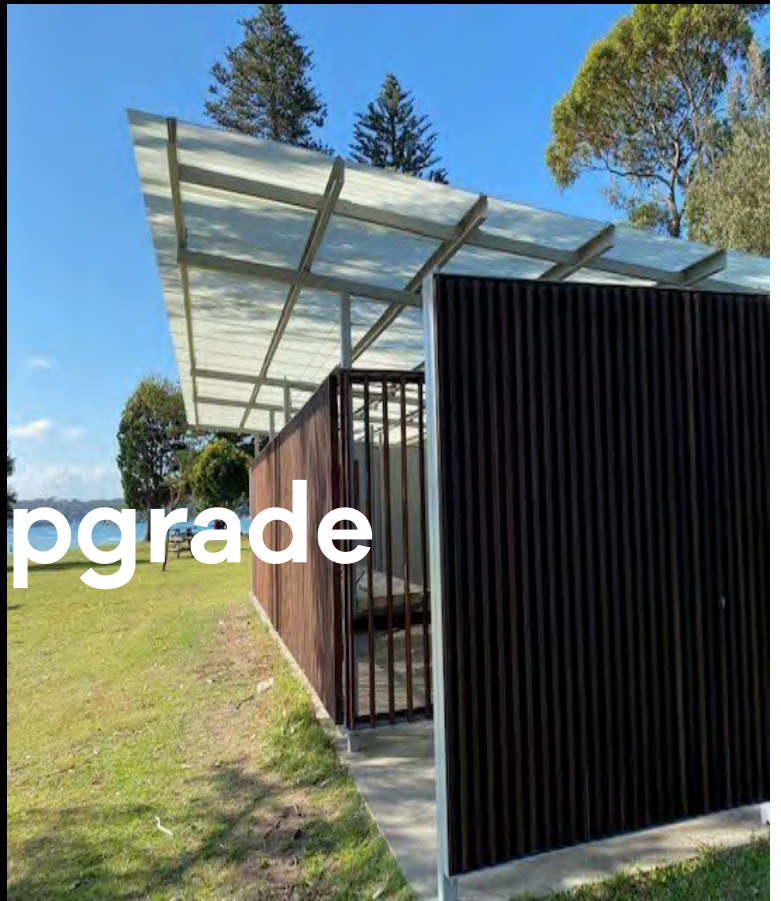


Bonnie Vale Amenities Upgrade

Overview

Bonnie Vale recreational area offers camping facilities, a boat launch area, swimming, fishing and kayaking in the waters of Port Hacking and nearby Cabbage Tree Basin.

NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service identified a need to upgrade amenities provided to visitors in the area. In addition to the amenities project, coastal protection works were undertaken within the western section of the picnic area as well as asbestos remediation works to the adjoining camping ground.

Challenges

- Ensuring public safety by isolating construction areas in a popular coastal location.
- Tight programme requirements.
- Managing a Covid lockdown to ensure the project programme was not adversely impacted.
- Minimising further disturbance of asbestos material around the existing amenities.

Services
