

Overview

Campbells Cove Promenade is a paved open space which provides pedestrian access from The Rocks around Sydney Harbour to Hickson Road and George Street North. It is part of the waterfront area that links land-based activities along the edge of the harbour including Walsh Bay, The Rocks and the Overseas Passenger Terminal (OPT).

To provide an integrated public domain outcome, works consisted of the demolition of the existing roadway at the northern end of the OPT, lowering the roadway level and roundabout, construction of new paving to provide safe access for pedestrians as well as level access for vehicles accessing the OPT.

Challenges

- Tight programme.
- OPT remaining operational as well as bars and restaurants remaining open.
- Liaising with and coordinating numerous stakeholders.

- Managing an increased security threat during construction
- Sharing the space with contractors on adjoining sites.
